Activities completed this week

- **Block D:**
 - 1st and 2nd fix trades, fire stopping work, and external trades (brickwork, window cills, rainwater pipes)
 - Scaffolding removed down another level
- **Knights Road:**
 - Phase 1 – planting, fencing and inspections
 - Phase 2 – Internal works and brickwork
 - Phase 3 - Brickwork, roofing and internal trades
 - Phase 4 – Brickwork
- **Highways:**
 - Preparation for tarmac - approximately 400 tonnes arrived on Friday!

Activities planned next week

- **Block D:**
 - Internal trades continuing including decorating , ceilling
 - External trades and scaffolding strike all to continue
- **Knights Road:**
 - Phase 1 – External trades / inspections
 - Phase 2 –Internal trades
 - Phase 3 – Brickwork, roofing and 1st fix
 - Phase 4 – Brickwork
- **Highway works**
 - Complete tarmac. When the tarmac is completed, Blackbird Leys Road will re-open on 2 way lights
